## From the Preacher's Desk

We serve a God of peace (1 Thessalonians 5:23). So as children of the Most High God, we should be people of peace. And we see in Scripture that, first of all, **God promises us access to His peace.** The apostle Paul would write that there is nothing in this world about which we should be anxious (Philippians 4:6). Friend, you can live a peaceful life. May we ever strive to let the peace of God rule our hearts (Colossians 3:15).
